Identity Breaches Surge: More Frequent, More Costly



69%

of organizations experienced an identity-related breach in the last three years

This was a 27% YoY increase representing a 64% relative jump.



45%

said identity breach costs exceeded the cost of typical security incidents



24%

reported costs exceeding \$10M

Help Desk Hijacks: A Top Threat Emerges



65%

of organizations are seriously concerned about attacks on their IT Help Desk, including social engineering and MFA bypass
